## **Craft Show Rules**

- Reservations will be accepted on a First-Come, First Served basis. Fees
  must accompany your reservation. Exhibitors requesting adjoining spaces
  must send applications in together. No refunds will be given after
  September 15, 2023, unless the festival is cancelled.
- The rental fee is \$75.00 per space or \$130.00 for two spaces. Booth space size is 12 x 12. Your money will be refunded if you <u>DO NOT</u> get a space. YOU WILL RECEIVE CONFIRMATION IN THE MAIL BY THE LAST WEEK IN SEPTEMBER. Confirmation will not be sent out before this time.
- Exhibitors will have the options of setting up exhibits on Friday, October  $20^{th}$ , between 1:00-6:00 pm and Saturday at 6:30 am. All cars must be unloaded and out of the area by 9:00 am on Saturday and by 10:00 am on Sunday. There will be no vehicle traffic allowed through festival areas after 9:00 am on Saturday and 10:00 am on Sunday.
- You are responsible for your own set-up. We do not provide tables. Our farm is located close to the river which causes windy conditions. If you have props you need to keep this in mind.
- Only handmade arts and crafts items may be sold. All items must be made or grown by vendor. No products may be sold that have been purchased from a wholesale handcraft distributor.
- No food or beverage may be sold at any vendor space.
- We will not be responsible for any losses or accidents that may occur. Security officers will be on the grounds Friday and Saturday night. Booths or tables left with merchandise are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- We will be reworking the craft space area and reducing some of the spaces to spread crafts booths out to help with social distancing. You may not get your spot if we do this in your area.
- We are not financially liable for the expenses that you may occur during the event the festival is cancelled due to weather conditions, the virus, or unforeseen circumstances.
